5. PFD News - Tyler Packer, the treasurer for the Fire Department Union, discussed Thanksgiving and Christmas boxes. He needs to know how many families. Bonnie Jackson has a list from the school with 5 families. The Fire Department will get a copy of the list from the school or Bonnie will drop off a copy at the fire station. The modular home at Parks has been painted and looks nice. The Bellemont overpass is closed until Friday. The FD requested that instead of PAC providing a Visa debit card to get food during a call, they would prefer if PAC reimburses them as the officers already have credit cards. Tyler is in paramedic class, which will end with his certification in January. After that is complete, he will be having monthly or quarterly CPR classes.
6. SFE Events/News - There was no one from SFE at the meeting, Item tabled.
7. School teacher supply drive - PAC collected $\$ 900$ for the teacher school supply drive. With an additional amount from PAC, we gave each of the 14 teachers at the school a $\$ 75$ gift card. We received a very nice thank you card.
8. Turkey Shoot results - Its over! This is the first year there were more shooters than spectators; Bobbi made turkey targets. Two turkeys were given away, 13 prizes plus 4 prizes for the safety officers; there are 24 prizes remaining for next year. George said thank you to all the helped and he appreciated the RV brought out by Pete and Jean Hicks. Ron Smith suggested using canopies next year, more tables and chairs, standardized targets with markings using a "fat sharpee" that can be seen better. Next year there will be 2 ranges and we may need an insurance rider, which may cost between $\$ 300-\$ 500$. We will look at Affinity and other insurance policies for next year, which will include this type of events and liability.
9. Square Credit Card Reader/PayPal - Square costs $2.75 \%$ per swipe. PAC (Joanie) will apply for the credit card reader over the winter hiatus. We also should set up a PayPal account for donations from our website.
10. Holiday Food Baskets - Bonnie oversees the holiday (Christmas time) food baskets. If anyone wants to donate food, contact her. Bunko usually buys hams. There are 5 families right now. The family with 8 children will be moving to Valle soon.
11. School Halloween Party - The Halloween festivities at the school will be Saturday, October $26^{\text {th }}$ from $4-7 \mathrm{pm}$. There will be games, pumpkin carving contest, costume contest, food and a trunk or treat.
12. Coconino County Parks and Rec Master Plan community meeting - The county Parks and Recreation meeting will be Wednesday, Oct 23 at 5:30, Maine School. Please spread the word.
13. Liability Insurance - Our current liability insurance policy ends April 2020. We may get quotes from other companies. Babs will investigate this over the winter hiatus.
