Community Assistance:

Coconino County Health and Human Services Community Services provides assistance based on income eligibility and other criteria required through the various programs for housing, utilities, and supportive services. Eligibility and the level of assistance are primarily based on family size and income at the time of service. There are offices in Flagstaff, Williams, Page and Fredonia. **All offices are closed to walk-in service. Please call for an appointment. 928-679-7453.**

Services Include:

- Utility assistance (electric, gas, propane)
- Utility deposits
- Utility related emergency home repairs (i.e., heater, hot water heaters)
- Move-in rental assistance*
- Eviction prevention rent assistance*
- Mortgage foreclosure prevention assistance
- Telephone assistance for medically needy households
- Food box and clothing referrals
- Firewood
- Medical Prescriptions - for prescriptions not covered by insurance
- COVID-19 Crisis Assistance

Women, Infants, and Children:

The Arizona Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) provides nutrition education and breastfeeding support services, supplemental nutritious foods and referrals to health and social services. WIC serves pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women; infants; and children under the age of five.

- Nutrition education
- Breastfeeding support
- Nutrition experts who specialize in nutrition for mothers and their children
- Information on nutrition and weight gain during pregnancy
- Tips for feeding infants and children to create healthy habits for a lifetime
- Referrals to health care and other community resources
- Healthy foods
